

VMware Installation on Ubuntu Server 8.04.1 64-bit

(CISS-150 William Jojo)

Packages to Install

As the installation user, perform the following:

```
sudo -s  
(Enter password for root shell)  
apt-get install build-essential  
apt-get install linux-headers-`uname -r`
```

(leave the root shell open for addition work)

Extract the VMware Distribution and the *any-any* patch.

While still in the root shell, perform the following:

Prepare the receiving directory:

```
mkdir vmware  
cd vmware
```

Get the software:

```
wget http://www.hvcc.edu/~w.jojo/vmware/vmware2.tar.gz
```

Extract the packages:

```
tar -zxf *.gz
```

Begin the installation (read carefully!):

```
cd vmware-server-distrib  
./vmware-install.pl
```

Accept the license agreement.

Configure the NAT network.

Say no to the bridged network.

Say no to host-only network configuration.

Enter the license key (from your instructor).

Verify that the installation completed successfully.
